PARTIES TO DISPUTE:

BROTHERHOOD OF MAINTENANCE OF WAY EMPLOYES CHICAGO, BURLINGTON & QUINCY RAILROAD COMPANY

STATEMENT OF CLAIM: Claim of the System Committee of the Brotherhood, based on Schedule Rule 56 of the current agreement, that W. H. Harris, Bridge and Building employe, be paid water service repairman helper's rate of \$126.54 a month in lieu of bridge and building laborer's rate of 43 cents an hour on all dates that he assisted the water service repairman on the Creston Division during June and July 1940.

FINDINGS: The Third Division of the Adjustment Board finds:

That the dispute was certified to the Third Division of the Adjustment Board ex parte by complainant party; and

That no hearing thereon has been held, and under date of September 24, 1942 the complainant party addressed a formal communication to the Secretary of the Third Division withdrawing this case, which request is hereby granted.

AWARD

Case dismissed.
