STATEMENT OF CLAIM: Claim of System Committee of the Brotherhood that Material Handlers at Great Falls, Montana, shall be paid at the rate of 62ϕ per hour from October 25, 1940 to August 31, 1941, and at the rate of 71ϕ per hour from September 1, 1941 to November 30, 1941, and at the rate of 72ϕ per hour from December 1, 1941.

FINDINGS: The Third Division of the Adjustment Board finds:

That the dispute was certified to the Third Division of the Adjustment Board ex parte by complainant party; and

That no hearing thereon has been held, and under date of February 10, 1943 the complainant party addressed a formal communication to the Secretary of the Third Division withdrawing this case, which request is hereby granted.

Case dismissed.
