GREAT NORTHERN RAILWAY COMPANY

STATEMENT OF CLAIM: Claim of System Committee of the Brotherhood that Material Handlers at Whitefish, Montana, shall be paid at the rate of 64ϕ per hour from April 1, 1941 to August 31, 1941, and at the rate of 73ϕ per hour from September 1 to November 30, 1941, and at the rate of 74ϕ per hour from December 1, 1941.

FINDINGS: The Third Division of the Adjustment Board finds:

That the dispute was certified to the Third Division of the Adjustment Board ex parte by complainant party; and

That no hearing thereon has been held, and under date of February 10, 1943 the complainant party addressed a formal communication to the Secretary of the Third Division withdrawing this case, which request is hereby eranted.

AWARD

Case dismissed.
