PARTIES TO DISPUTE:

BROTHERHOOD OF RAILWAY AND STEAMSHIP CLERKS, FREIGHT HANDLERS, EXPRESS AND STATION EMPLOYES

NORTHERN PACIFIC TERMINAL COMPANY OF OREGON

STATEMENT OF CLAIM: Claim of the System Committee of the Brotherhood of Railway and Steamship Clerks, Freight Handlers, Express and Station Employes that:

- (1) Carrier violated the Clerks' Agreement when on January 16, 1943, it created a new position and assigned clerical work to an employe not covered by said agreement, and failed and refused to assign such clerical work to employes holding seniority rights thereto, and
- (2) That senior qualified clerk shall now be assigned to said position and be paid Yardmaster's rate for each day's work performed by the Yardmaster assigned to said position, and
- (3) That all employes involved or affected by this agreement violation be compensated for all wage loss sustained.

FINDINGS: The Third Division of the Adjustment Board finds:

That the dispute was certified to the Third Division of the Adjustment Board ex parte by complainant party; and

That no hearing thereon has been held, and under date of July 16, 1943, the complainant party addressed a formal communication to the Secretary of the Third Division requesting withdrawal of this case, which request is hereby granted.

AWARD

Case dismissed.
