JOINT COUNCIL DINING CAR EMPLOYES CHICAGO, INDIANAPOLIS & LOUISVILLE RAILWAY CO.

STATEMENT OF CLAIM: Claim of the Joint Council Dining Car Employes, Local 351, Hotel & Restaurant Employes International Alliance, on the property of the Chicago, Indianapolis and Louisville Railway Company, for and in behalf of Mr. W. Todd for the month of September 1941, for \$11.02, October 1941, for \$17.51 and November 1941, for \$10.46, the balance due him under the terms of the Agreement effective January 20, 1942, and:

A similar claim for each of the employes in this class, for back pay for the months of September, October and November 1941, the full amount of \$21.60, for each of the months indicated above less the amounts having already been paid.

FINDINGS The Third Division of the Adjustment Board finds:

That the dispute was certified to the Third Division of the Adjustment Board ex parte by complainant party; and

That hearing thereon was waived. Under dates of July 13, 1943 and July 24, 1943, the parties addressed formal communications to the Secretary of the Third Division requesting withdrawal of this dispute, which request is hereby granted.

AWARD

Case dismissed.
