## PARTIES TO DISPUTE:

## BROTHERHOOD OF MAINTENANCE OF WAY EMPLOYES MISSOURI PACIFIC RAILROAD COMPANY

STATEMENT OF CLAIM: Claim of the System Committee of the Brotherhood—

- (a) That J. H. Pyle, B. & B. Foreman, Omaha Division, was unjustly dismissed from the service of the Carrier on October 17, 1942; and
- (b) That J. H. Pyle be reinstated with seniority unimpaired and paid for all time lost from the date of his dismissal until he is returned to service.

FINDINGS The Third Division of the Adjustment Board finds:

That the dispute was certified to the Third Division of the Adjustment Board ex parte by complainant party; and

That no hearing thereon has been held, and under date of July 19, 1943, the complainant party addressed a formal communication to the Secretary of the Third Division requesting withdrawal of this case, which request is hereby granted.

## AWARD

Case dismissed.
