BROTHERHOOD OF MAINTENANCE OF WAY EMPLOYES SOUTHERN PACIFIC LINES IN TEXAS & LOUISIANA

STATEMENT OF CLAIM: Claim of the System Committee of the Brotherhood

- (a) That J. J. Tatum and J. P. Coleman, Bridgetenders, Berwick, Louisiana, Lafayette Division, were incorrectly paid from December 12, 1941 to January 25, 1942;
- (b) That J. J. Tatum and J. P. Coleman be paid the difference between compensation received and what they were entitled to receive during the above period.

FINDINGS: The Third Division of the Adjustment Board finds:

That the dispute was certified to the Third Division of the Adjustment Board ex parte by complainant party; and

That no hearing thereon has been held, and under date of November 3, 1943, the complainant party addressed a formal communication to the Secretary of the Third Division requesting withdrawal of this case, which request is hereby granted.

AWARD

Case dismissed.
