STATEMENT OF CLAIM: Claim of the System Committee that the Carrier violated the Clerk's Agreement of November 15, 1926.

- (a) When it failed to assign Miss E. Ray Sullivan to the position of Per Diem Clerk as advertised by Vacancy Bulletin No. 16, effective May 11, 1942, and that,
- (b) Miss E. Ray Sullivan shall now be compensated for the difference between what she has earned and \$164.60 per month, for the period from May 11, 1942 to October 1, 1942, and from November 9, 1942 to January 2, 1943, when she was assigned the present position of Per Diem Clerk, rate \$164.60 per month.

FINDINGS: The Third Division of the Adjustment Board finds:

That the dispute was certified to the Third Division of the Adjustment Board ex parte by complainant party; and

That no hearing thereon has been held, and under date of November 16, 1943, the complainant party addressed a formal communication to the Secretary of the Third Division requesting withdrawal of this case, which request is hereby granted.

AWARD

Case dismissed.
