STATEMENT OF CLAIM: Claim of the System Committee of the Brotherhood of Railway and Steamship Clerks, Freight Handlers, Express and Station Employes on the Chicago, Rock Island and Pacific Railway Company that:

- 1. Mr. Jess Garwick, Mail Handler, Des Moines, Iowa, rate \$150.70 per month, assigned hours 11:30 P.M. to 8:00 A.M., 30 minutes for lunch, be reimbursed for time held out of service February 11, 1943 to May 11, 1943 inclusive, and
- 2. That Mr. Jess Garwik be allowed expenses incurred account these charges as follows: Attorney fees \$100.00 and Bond cost \$50.00, money he was forced to pay out.

FINDINGS: The Third Division of the Adjustment Board finds:

That the dispute was certified to the Third Division of the Adjustment Board ex parte by complainant party; and

That no hearing thereon has been held, and under date of November 18, 1943, the complainant party addressed a formal communication to the Secretary of the Third Division requesting withdrawal of this case, which request is hereby granted.

AWARD

Case dismissed.
