## PARTIES TO DISPUTE:

## THE ORDER OF RAILROAD TELEGRAPHERS THE PENNSYLVANIA RAILROAD COMPANY

STATEMENT OF CLAIM: Claim of the General Committee of The Order of Railroad Telegraphers on The Pennsylvania Railroad,

- (a) that Agent A. E. Larson, Falls Creek, Pa., required to work his regular assigned relief day (day of rest), Sunday, July 5, 12, 19, and 26; August 16, 23 and 30; and September 20, 1942; and other Sundays thereafter, was not properly compensated; and
- (b) that he shall be compensated for this service at one and one-half times the daily rate of the Agent's position.

FINDINGS: The Third Division of the Adjustment Board finds:

That the dispute was certified to the Third Division of the Adjustment Board ex parte by complainant party; and

That no hearing thereon has been held, and under date of February 15, 1944, the complainant party addressed a formal communication to the Secretary of the Third Division withdrawing this case, which request is hereby granted.

## AWARD

Claim dismissed.
