M., October 28, 1942, to 8:30 P. M., same day, and eight (8) additional hours held for service during the period from 9:35 P. M., October 29, to 8:30 P. M., October 31st, as provided in Rule 9, Agreement between The Pullman Company and Conductors in the Service of The Pullman Company.
