STATEMENT OF CLAIM: Claim of the General Committee of the Order of Railroad Telegraphers, on The Pennsylvania Railroad that the positions in the following Towers on the Philadelphia Terminal Division: Woodbine; 52nd Street; HV-8; and M-1, shall be placed under the jurisdiction of the Telegraphers' Agreement, bulletined and filled in accordance with the provisions thereof. Regulation 8-B-1.

FINDINGS: The Third Division of the Adjustment Board finds:

That the dispute was certified to the Third Division of the Adjustment Board ex parte by complainant party; and
