STATEMENT OF CLAIM: Claim of the System Committee of the Brotherhood that Mr. Zach Pierce, Bill Clerk, Durango, Colorado, be compensated under the Call Rule, account not being called to perform service, October 31, November 7, December 25, 1943, and January 1, 1944 and subsequent thereto, such service being performed by other than employes coming within the scope of the Clerks' Agreement.

FINDINGS: The Third Division of the Adjustment Board finds:

That the dispute was certified to the Third Division of the Adjustment Board ex parte by complainant party; and

That no hearing thereon has been held, and under date of October 18, 1944, the complainant party addressed a formal communication to the Secretary of the Third Division requesting withdrawal of this case, which request is hereby granted.

AWARD

Case dismissed.
