PARTIES TO DISPUTE:

THE ORDER OF RAILROAD TELEGRAPHERS PEORIA TERMINAL COMPANY

STATEMENT OF CLAIM: Claim of the General Committee of The Order of Railroad Telegraphers Peoria Terminal Company (a) that the carrier violated the Telegraphers' Agreement by refraining from Advertising the vacancy on the position of agent at Pekin, Illinois, to all employes covered by said Agreement in the Terminal when the position became vacant about June, 1937, and by refraining from filling the vacancy in the manner provided in said Agreement; (b) and that the position shall be advertised and filled in accordance with the governing rules of the prevailing Telegraphers' Agreement.

FINDINGS: The Third Division of the Adjustment Board finds:

That the dispute was certified to the Third Division of the Adjustment Board ex parte by complainant party; and

That no hearing thereon has been held, and under date of January 4, 1945, the complainant party addressed a formal communication to the secretary of the Third Division withdrawing this case, which is hereby granted.

AWARD

Case dismissed.
