STATEMENT OF CLAIM: Claim of the Joint Council Dining Car Employes, Local 495, for and in behalf of Waiters H. H. Diggs, H. Williams, W. M. Stiles, R. A. Payne, J. T. Wilkins and B. P. Vincent, to have their records cleared of the discipline imposed upon them, by suspension of 15 days, and for compensation to the extent each of them has suffered, as a result of carrier's refusal to grant them an appeal as provided in Rule 2 of the agreement.

FINDINGS: The Third Division of the Adjustment Board finds:

That the dispute was certified to the Third Division of the Adjustment Board ex parte by complainant party; and

That no hearing thereon has been held, and under date of July 6, 1945, the complainant party addressed a formal communication to the Secretary of the Third Division withdrawing this case, which request is hereby granted.

AWARD

Case dismissed.
