**STATEMENT OF CLAIM:** Claim of the System Committee of the Brotherhood that:

(a) The Carrier violated the Clerks' Agreement on May 18, 1944, when it refused to assign Miss Minnette Crittenden to the position of Division Engineer's Clerk at Palestine, Texas; also

(b) Claim that Miss Crittenden now be assigned to the position and compensated for all losses sustained.

**FINDINGS:** The Third Division of the Adjustment Board finds:

That the dispute was certified to the Third Division of the Adjustment Board ex parte by complainant party; and

That no hearing thereon has been held, and under date of December 3, 1945, the complainant party addressed a formal communication to the Secretary of the Third Division requesting withdrawal of the case, which request is hereby granted.

**AWARD**

Case dismissed.
