BROTHERHOOD OF RAILWAY AND STEAMSHIP CLERKS, FREIGHT HANDLERS, EXPRESS AND STATION EMPLOYES

READING COMPANY

STATEMENT OF CLAIM: Claim of the System Committee of the Brotherhood that the Carrier violated the Clerk's Agreement:

- 1. When on December 9, 1943, John F. Arnold, platform trucker, was removed from the service and not permitted to return to duty until April 17, 1944.
- 2. That Mr. Arnold be compensated for all monetary loss sustained by him by reason of the Carrier's action from December 9, 1943 to April 16, 1944 inclusive.

FINDINGS: The Third Division of the Adjustment Board finds:

That the dispute was certified to the Third Division of the Adjustment Board ex parte by complainant party; and

That no hearing thereon has been held, and under date of December 13, 1945 the complainant party addressed a formal communication to the Secretary of the Third Division requesting withdrawal of this case, which request is hereby granted.

AWARD

Case dismissed.
