STATEMENT OF CLAIM: (a) Claim that the carrier violated the provisions of our current agreement when it assigned the work of repairing duct line between 22nd and 63rd Streets, Chicago, Illinois, to Bridge and Building Department employes, between October 25 and December 30, 1939.

(b) Claim of J. Leameister and R. Taylor for signalman's rate of pay, 87 cents per hour, and claim of R. Schultz, F. Beloken and R. Campbell for helper's rate of pay, 63 cents per hour, during the time they were on furlough between October 25 and December 30, 1939.

FINDINGS: The Third Division of the Adjustment Board finds:

That the dispute was certified to the Third Division of the Adjustment Board ex parte by complainant party; and

That no hearing thereon has been held, and under date of Jan. 18, 1946, the complainant party addressed a formal communication to the Secretary of the Third Division requesting withdrawal of this case, which request is hereby granted.

AWARD

Case dismissed.
