JOINT COUNCIL DINING CAR EMPLOYES CHICAGO, BURLINGTON & QUINCY RAILROAD COMPANY

STATEMENT OF CLAIM: Claim of the Joint Council Dining Car Employes, Local 351, on the property of the Chicago, Burlington & Quincy Railroad Company, for and on behalf of Mr. W. L. Tubbs, Waiter for compensation for time earned by his asignment (but lost by him) from June 7, 1945, until he is actually returned to his former position in the service.

FINDINGS: The Third Division of the Adjustment Board finds:

That the dispute was certified to the Third Division of the Adjustment Board ex parte by complainant party; and

That no hearing thereon has been held, and under date of May 23, 1946, the complainant party addressed a formal communication to the Secretary of the Third Division requesting withdrawal of this case, which request is hereby granted.

Case dismissed.
