PARTIES TO DISPUTE:

BROTHERHOOD OF MAINTENANCE OF WAY EMPLOYEES

MISSOURI-KANSAS-TEXAS RAILROAD COMPANY

STATEMENT OF CLAIM: Claim of the System Committee of the Brotherhood that J. R. Villareal, section laborer, San Antonio, Texas, who was temporarily assigned to relieve a crossing watchman from July 17 to 29, 1946, inclusive, shall, under the application of Article 8, Rule 1, of the Maintenance of Way Agreement, be paid at the rate of time and one-half for services rendered on Sundays, July 21 and July 28, 1946.

FINDINGS: The Third Division of the Adjustment Board finds:

That the dispute was certified to the Third Division of the Adjustment Board ex parte by complainant party; and

That no hearing thereon has been held, and under date of April 4, 1947, the complainant party addressed a formal communication to the Secretary of the Third Division requesting withdrawal of this case, which request is hereby granted.

AWARD

Case dismissed.
