PARTIES TO DISPUTE:

BROTHERHOOD OF RAILWAY AND STEAMSHIP CLERKS, FREIGHT HANDLERS, EXPRESS AND STATION EMPLOYES

THE ERIE RAILROAD COMPANY

STATEMENT OF CLAIM: Claim of the System Committee of the Brotherhood that the Carrier violates the Clerks' Agreement:

- (1) When it requires and permits the Freight Agent at Barberton,
 Ohio, an employe not covered by any agreement to perform more than four
 (4) hours clerical work daily, and
- (2) That Carrier shall now be required to establish position of Clerk-Typist, Barberton, Ohio and fill same in accordance with the provisions of the Clerks' Agreement, and
- (3) That Carrier shall reimburse the successful applicant and all other employes affected for any and all wage loss sustained retroactive to December 16, 1945.

FINDINGS: The Third Division of the Adjustment Board finds:

That the dispute was certified to the Third Division of the Adjustment Board ex parte by complainant party; and

That no hearing thereon has been held and under date of May 29, 1947, the complainant party addressed a formal communication to the Secretary of the Third Division requesting withdrawal of this case, which request is hereby granted.

AWARD

Case dismissed.
