BROTHERHOOD OF RAILWAY AND STEAMSHIP CLERKS, FREIGHT HANDLERS, EXPRESS AND STATION EMPLOYES

LEHIGH VALLEY RAILROAD COMPANY

STATEMENT OF CLAIM: Claim of the System Committee of the Brotherhood that the Carrier violated the Clerks' Agreement.

- 1. When it failed and refused to compensate employes for time lost due to death in family as had been the established practice for over thirty-five years and which the Carrier arbitrarily canceled without conference or agreement with the Committee.
- 2. That Carrier be required to compensate employe Mrs. Stella Danahy Wishart, Niagara Falls, N. Y., for time lost October 25, 26, 28 and 29, 1946 account of the death of her father.

FINDINGS: The Third Division of the Adjustment Board finds:

That the dispute was certified to the Third Division of the Adjustment Board ex parte by complainant party; and

That no hearing thereon has been held, and under date of June 16, 1947, the complainant party addressed a formal communication to the Secretary of the Third Division requesting withdrawal of this case, which request is hereby granted.

AWARD

Case dismissed.
