STATEMENT OF CLAIM: Claim of the System Committee of the Brotherhood that section foreman Donald J. Curtis and section men John R. Salts, Harley D. Essary, Arnold R. Laughridge, and Orville A. Troxel be paid two (2) hours and forty (40) minutes at time and one-half rate for a call by reason of not being notified or called to perform emergency work on their assigned section No. 319, Eldon, Iowa, the night of September 26, 1945.

FINDINGS: The Third Divison of the Adjustment Board finds:

That the dispute was certified to the Third Division of the Adjustment Board ex parte by complainant party; and

That no hearing thereon has been held, and under date of September 23, 1947, the complainant party addressed a formal communication to the secretary of the Third Division requesting withdrawal of this case, which request is hereby granted.

AWARD

Case dismissed.
