**PARTIES TO DISPUTE:**

**BROTHERHOOD OF RAILROAD TRAINMEN**

**LOUISVILLE AND NASHVILLE RAILROAD COMPANY**

**STATEMENT OF CLAIM:** Claim for all dining car stewards for pay at regular hourly rates until 11:30 P.M., when released from duty for purposes of pay earlier than that hour, while traveling with their cars, since July 13, 1938.

**FINDINGS:** The Third Division of the Adjustment Board finds:

That the dispute was certified to the Third Division of the Adjustment Board ex parte by complainant party; and

That hearing was waived by the parties and case handled to a conclusion; under dates of April 9th and 15th, 1948, the parties addressed formal communications to the Secretary of the Third Division requesting withdrawal of this case, which request is hereby granted.

**AWARD**

Case dismissed.
