STATEMENT OF CLAIM: Claim of the System Committee of the Brotherhood of Railway and Steamship Clerks, Freight Handlers, Express and Station Employes:

- 1. That the Carrier's action in removing Mr. W. S. Lee from position of Chief Clerk, Waycross, Ga., Agency, on January 2, 1948 was not justified by the facts and that Mr. Lee shall be returned to the position of Chief
- 2. That Mr. W. S. Lee shall be paid for all monetary loss because of being removed from position of Chief Clerk, Waycross, Ga. agency on January 2, 1948, until his return to that position.

FINDINGS: The Third Division of the Adjustment Board finds:

That the dispute was certified to the Third Division of the Adjustment Board ex parte by complainant party; and

That no hearing thereon has been held, and under date of November 22, 1948, the complainant party addressed a formal communication to the Acting Secretary of the Third Division withdrawing this case, which request is

Case dismissed.
