BROTHERHOOD OF RAILWAY AND STEAMSHIP CLERKS, FREIGHT HANDLERS, EXPRESS AND STATION EMPLOYES

TERMINAL RAILROAD ASSOCIATION OF ST. LOUIS

STATEMENT OF CLAIM: Claim of the Terminal Board of Adjustment, Brotherhood of Railway and Steamship Clerks, Freight Handlers, Express and Station Employes that the Carrier violated the Clerks' Agreement:

- (1) When the Carrier blanked positions necessary to the continuous operation of the Carrier on dates of February 8, 13, 14 and 15, 1948.
- (2) That claimant as designated in claim filed February 17, 1948, copy of which is attached as Employes' Exhibit "A", be compensated at the punitive rate for the dates involved.

FINDINGS: The Third Division of the Adjustment Board finds:

That the dispute was certified to the Third Division of the Adjustment Board ex parte by complainant party; and

That no hearing thereon has been held and under date of November 19, 1948, the complainant party addressed a formal communication to the Acting Secretary of the Third Division withdrawing this case, which request is hereby granted.

AWARD

Case dismissed.
