BROTHERHOOD OF RAILWAY AND STEAMSHIP CLERKS, FREIGHT HANDLERS, EXPRESS AND STATION EMPLOYES

THE ERIE RAILROAD COMPANY

STATEMENT OF CLAIM: Claim of the System Committee of the Brotherhood that the carrier is violating the rules of the Clerks' Agreement at Meadville, Pennsylvania by requiring and permitting an employe not covered by the Clerks' Agreement to perform work covered thereby, and

That the carrier shall re-establish position of Ticket Clerk at Meadville, Pennsylvania, retroactive to January 19, 1946, bulletin, award and assign same to senior qualified applicant, and

That such senior applicant and all others affected shall be reimbursed for wage loss sustained retroactive to January 19, 1946.

FINDINGS: The Third Division of the Adjustment Board finds:

That the dispute was certified to the Third Division of the Adjustment Board ex parte by complainant party; and

That no hearing thereon has been held and under date of November 12, 1948, the complainant party addressed a formal communication to the Acting Secretary of the Third Division withdrawing this case, which request is hereby granted.

AWARD

Case dismissed.
