PARTIES TO DISPUTE:

BROTHERHOOD OF RAILWAY AND STEAMSHIP CLERKS, FREIGHT HANDLERS, EXPRESS AND STATION EMPLOYES

TENNESSEE CENTRAL RAILWAY COMPANY

STATEMENT OF CLAIM: Claim of the System Committee of the Brotherhood that Carrier violated the Clerks' Agreement:

- (1) When on July 27, 1948 it failed and refused to assign Clerk E. S. Hackney to position of Timekeeper covered by Carrier's Bulletin No. 169 dated July 22, 1948, and
- (2) That E. S. Hackney be assigned to position covered by Bulletin No. 169 and be paid the difference between rate he received, \$219.36 per month, and rate he properly should have received, \$291.12 per month, retroactive to July 27, 1948.

FINDINGS: The Third Division of the Adjustment Board finds:

That the dispute was certified to the Third Division of the Adjustment Board ex parte by the complainant party; and

That no hearing thereon has been held, and under date of April 4, 1949, the complainant party addressed a formal communication to the Acting Secretary of the Third Division requesting withdrawal of this case, which request is hereby granted.

AWARD

Case dismissed.
