PARTIES TO DISPUTE:

BROTHERHOOD OF RAILWAY AND STEAMSHIP CLERKS, FREIGHT HANDLERS, EXPRESS AND STATION EMPLOYES

DELAWARE, LACKAWANNA AND WESTERN RAILROAD COMPANY

STATEMENT OF CLAIM: Claim of the System Committee of the Brotherhood that:

- (1) The Carrier violated the terms of the Clerks' Agreement when it refused to carry out specific provisions contained in Letter of Understanding signed March 7, 1945, dealing with leave of absence granted Clerk Maurice Coffey; and
- (2) Claim that the Carrier shall be required to cancel said Letter of Understanding and remove the name and seniority dates of Maurice Coffey from all rosters listing such dates retroactive to June 1, 1946.

FINDINGS: The Third Division of the Adjustment Board finds:

That the dispute was certified to the Third Division of the Adjustment Board ex parte by the complainant party; and

That no hearing thereon has been held, and under date of August 23, 1949 the complainant party addressed a formal communication to the Acting Secretary of the Third Division requesting withdrawal of this case, which request is hereby granted.

AWARD

Claim dismissed.
