STATEMENT OF CLAIM: Claim of the System Committee, Brotherhood of Railway and Steamship Clerks, Freight Handlers, Express and Station Employes that J. E. Brown, Seal Clerk, Columbus, Georgia, be compensated for wage loss sustained when held out of service from March 12, to March 31, 1948 inclusive (17 days) resulting in compensation loss to the extent of seventeen (17) days pay at rate of \$10.012 per day or \$270.32 per month, total of \$170.21.

FINDINGS: The Third Division of the Adjustment Board finds:

That the dispute was certified to the Third Division of the Adjustment Board ex parte by the complainant party; and

That no hearing thereon has been held, and under date of September 28, 1949, the complainant party addressed a formal communication to the Acting Secretary of the Third Division requesting withdrawal of this case, which request is hereby granted.

AWARD

Case dismissed.
