## JOINT COUNCIL DINING CAR EMPLOYES SEABOARD AIRLINE RAILWAY COMPANY

STATEMENT OF CLAIM: Claim of Joint Council Dining Car Employes, Local 495, for and on behalf of Waiters, Harry Days, W. L. Turner, Oliver Mitchell and Chair Car Attendant W. N. Freeman on the property of Seaboard Airline Railway Company that they be compensated for wages they would have earned between December 28, 1946 through January 1, 1947, which such wages were not paid to them by Carrier in violation of the Current Agreement.

FINDINGS: The Third Division of the Adjustment Board finds:

That the dispute was certified to the Third Division of the Adjustment Board ex parte by the complainant party; and

That no hearing thereon has been held, and under date of January 5, 1950, the complainant party addressed a formal communication to the Acting Secretary of the Third Division requesting withdrawal of this case, which request is hereby granted.

## AWARD

Case dismissed.
