### PARTIES TO DISPUTE:

## BROTHERHOOD OF RAILWAY AND STEAMSHIP CLERKS, FREIGHT HANDLERS, EXPRESS AND STATION EMPLOYES

### THE PENNSYLVANIA RAILROAD COMPANY

STATEMENT OF CLAIM: Claim of the System Committee of the Brotherhood that:

- (a) The Carrier violated the provisions of the Rules Agreement, effective May 1, 1942, particularly the Scope, Rule 4-A-6, and Paragraph 1-B of Supplemental Agreement "A," Canton Freight Station, Baltimore, Maryland, Maryland Division, January 4 to March 3: inclusive, 1947, by using so-called emergency or contract employes in lieu of available employes holding regular or regular extra list positions.
- (b) P. G. Wright, K. W. Johnson and others be paid five hours' pay at time and one-half for each date available during this period. (Docket E-503 & E-565).

FINDINGS: The Third Division of the Adjustment Board finds:

That the dispute was certified to the Third Division of the Adjustment Board ex parte by the complainant party; and

That no hearing thereon has been held, and under date of January 19, 1950, the complainant party addressed a formal communication to the Acting Secretary of the Third Division requesting withdrawal of this case, which request is hereby granted.

#### AWARD

Case dismissed.
