NATIONAL RAILROAD ADJUSTMENT BOARD THIRD DIVISION

PARTIES TO DISPUTE:

BROTHERHOOD OF MAINTENANCE OF WAY EMPLOYES TUCSON, CORNELIA AND GILA BEND RAILROAD COMPANY

STATEMENT OF CLAIM: Claim of the System Committee of the Brotherhood:

- (1) That the Carrier violated the agreement during June and July, 1949, when it reduced the monthly rate of pay of Section Foreman J. G. Dorame and A. V. Soto.
- (2) That Section Foremen J. G. Dorame and A. V. Soto be paid \$62.10 each, less authorized deductions, because their basic salary was arbitrarily reduced during the period referred to in part (1) of this claim.

FINDINGS: The Third Division of the Adjustment Board finds:

That the dispute was certified to the Third Division of the Adjustment Board ex parte by complainant party; and

That no hearing thereon has been held and under date of August 1, 1950, the complainant party addressed a formal communication to the Acting Secretary of the Third Division requesting withdrawal of this case, which request is hereby granted.

AWARD

Case dismissed.
