PARTIES TO DISPUTE:

THE ORDER OF RAILROAD TELEGRAPHERS

TENNESSEE CENTRAL RAILWAY COMPANY

STATEMENT OF CLAIM: Claim of the General Committee of The Order of Railroad Telegraphers on the Tennessee Central Railway Company that J. R. Tarpley, extra operator-clerk, who was available but who was not used to provide vacation relief service on the operator-clerk position at Crossville, Tennessee, August 1, 2, 4, 5, 6, 7, 8, 9, and 11, 1949, shall be compensated for 8 hours on each of these dates at the rate of \$1.26 per hour as a result of the Carrier's action in depriving Claimant of work to which he was entitled on the seniority basis.

FINDINGS: The Third Division of the Adjustment Board finds:

That the dispute was certified to the Third Division of the Adjustment Board ex parte by complainant party; and

That no hearing thereon has been held and under date of September 18, 1950, the complainant party addressed a formal communication to the Acting Secretary of the Third Division requesting the withdrawal of this case, which request is hereby **granted**.

AWARD

Case dismissed.
