## PARTIES TO DISPUTE:

# JOINT COUNCIL DINING CAR EMPLOYES

## GREAT NORTHERN RAILWAY COMPANY

STATEMENT OF CLAIM: Claim of Joint Council Dining Car Employes, Local 516, for and behalf of Horace Daniels and other employes similarly situated on the property of Great Northern Railway Company that they be compensated for sixty-seven (67) hours each at the rate of \$1.145 per hour as a result of Carrier's terminating assignment for the employes affected on Trains 54-53, 3-4, effective June 29, 1950, in violation of agreement.

FINDINGS: The Third Division of the Adjustment Board, after giving the parties to this dispute due notice of hearing thereon and upon the whole record and all the evidence, finds and holds:

That the Carrier and the Employes involved in this dispute are respectively Carrier and Employes within the meaning of the Railway Labor Act, as approved June 21, 1934;

That this Division of the Adjustment Board has jurisdiction over the dispute involved herein;

That the dispute was certified to the Third Division of the Adjustment Board ex parte by complainant party; and

That hearing thereon has been held but not concluded. Under date of July 12, 1951 the Petitioner addressed a formal communication to the Acting Secretary of the Third Division, requesting withdrawal of this case from further consideration by the Division, which request is hereby granted.

#### AWARD

Case dismissed.
