## PARTIES TO DISPUTE:

## BROTHERHOOD OF MAINTENANCE OF WAY EMPLOYES THE DELAWARE AND HUDSON RAILROAD CORPORATION

STATEMENT OF CLAIM: Claim of the System Committee of the Brotherhood, that:

- (1) The Carrier violated the effective agreement when they failed to permit Trackmen John R. Struckle and Kenneth R. Barber to perform overtime service between the hours of 5:30 P. M. January 26, 1949 and 3:30 A. M. January 27, 1949;
- (2) Trackmen John R. Struckle and Kenneth R. Barber be allowed six (6) hours pay at their respective time and one-ralf rates and four (4) hours pay at their respective double time rate because of the violation referred to in part (1) of this claim.

FINDINGS: The Third Division of the Adjustment Board finds:

That the dispute was certified to the Third Division of the Adjustment Board ex parte by complainant party; and

That no hearing thereon has been held, and under date of December 7, 1951, the complainant party addressed a formal communication to the Acting Secretary of the Third Division requesting withdrawal of this case, which request is hereby granted.

## AWARD

Case dismissed.
