PARTIES TO DISPUTE:

**BROTHERHOOD OF RAILWAY AND STEAMSHIP CLERKS,
FREIGHT HANDLERS, EXPRESS AND STATION EMPLOYES**

RAILWAY EXPRESS AGENCY, INC.

STATEMENT OF CLAIM: Claim of the District Committee of the Brotherhood that

(a) The agreement governing hours of service and working conditions between the Railway Express Agency and the Brotherhood of Railway & Steamship Clerks, Freight Handlers, Express & Station Employees, effective September 1, 1949, was violated at Kensett, Arkansas, when J. R. Cowen, Transfer Clerk, was refused and not allowed vacation with pay in 1950, and

(b) He shall now be compensated the amount equivalent to the vacation with pay due him in 1950.

FINDINGS: The Third Division of the Adjustment Board, after giving the parties to this dispute due notice of hearing thereon and upon the whole record and all the evidence, finds and holds:

That the Carrier and the Employees involved in this dispute are respectively Carrier and Employees within the meaning of the Railway Labor Act, as approved June 21, 1934;

That this Division of the Adjustment Board has jurisdiction over the dispute involved herein;

That the dispute was certified to the Third Division of the Adjustment Board ex parte by the complainant party; and

That hearing thereon has been held and concluded. Under date of March 17, 1952, the parties jointly advised the Acting Secretary of the Third Division of their desire to withdraw this case from further consideration by the Division, which request is hereby granted.

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AWARD

Case dismissed.
