## PARTIES TO DISPUTE:

## GULF, MOBILE AND OHIO RAILROAD COMPANY THE ORDER OF RAILROAD TELEGRAPHERS

**STATEMENT OF CLAIM:** Claim that the Carrier violates the agreement when conductors on passenger trains cut cash fares at certain stations where employes are off duty as a result of the application of the agreement effective September 1, 1949.

FINDINGS: The Third Division of the Adjustment Board finds:

That the dispute was certified to the Third Division of the Adjustment Board ex parte by the complainant party; and

That no hearing thereon has been held, and under date of January 26, 1953, the complainant party addressed a formal communication to the Secretary of the Third Division requesting withdrawal of this case, which request is hereby granted.

## AWARD

Case dismissed.
