BROTHERHOOD OF RAILWAY & STEAMSHIP CLERKS, FREIGHT HANDLERS, EXPRESS & STATION EMPLOYES

GREAT NORTHERN RAILWAY COMPANY

STATEMENT OF CLAIM: Claim of the System Committee of the Brotherhood of Railway and Steamship Clerks, Freight Handlers, Express and Station Employes that the Carrier violated the Clerks' Agreement,

- 1. When on January 17, 1951, the Carrier set up a so-called combination clerk and relief position at Billings Freighthouse, Billings, Montana, in violation of Rule 43.
- 2. That the Carrier now be required to compensate E. J. Carbone at the time and one-half rate for Saturday and Sunday, also at the straight time rate for Tuesday and Wednesday, his days off, and for each and every day that this violation continued.
- 3. That Clerk A. J. Holtzbauer be compensated at the time and one-half rate for Saturday and Sunday and at the straight time rate for Monday, and for each and every day that this violation continued.
- 4. That Clerk C. S. Konecny be compensated for eight hours at the time and one-half rate for each Saturday and Sunday he was not called to perform work on his position on these two days, account employe assigned to a relief position, and for each and every day that the violation continued.

FINDINGS: The Third Division of the Adjustment Board finds:

That the dispute was certified to the Third Division of the Adjustment Board ex parte by the complainant party; and

That no hearing thereon has been held, and under date of June 2, 1953, the complainant party addressed a formal communication to the Secretary of the Third Division requesting withdrawal of this case, which request is hereby granted.

AWARD

Case dismissed.
