NATIONAL RAILROAD ADJUSTMENT BOARD THIRD DIVISION

PARTIES TO DISPUTE:

BROTHERHOOD OF MAINTENANCE OF WAY EMPLOYES ILLINOIS CENTRAL RAILROAD COMPANY

STATEMENT OF CLAIM: Claim of the System Committee of the Brotherhood that:

- (1) The Carrier violated the Agreement when it called employes assigned to Section J-4, Memphis, Tennessee, to perform work on Section J-3 on Saturday, February 16, 1952, in lieu of calling employes holding seniority on and assigned to Section J-3;
- (2) Section Laborers William Applewhite, Mitchel Davis, and Wilson Harris each be allowed payment for a call under the provision of Rule 39; account of the violation referred to in part (1) of this claim.

FINDINGS: The Third Division of the Adjustment Board, after giving the parties to this dispute due notice of hearing thereon and upon the whole record and all the evidence, finds and holds:

That the Carrier and the Employes involved in this dispute are respectively Carrier and Employes within the meaning of the Railway Labor Act, as approved June 21, 1934;

That this Division of the Adjustment Board has jurisdiction over the dispute involved herein;

That the dispute was certified to the Third Division of the Adjustment Board jointly by the parties; and

That hearing thereon has been held and concluded. Under date of December 14, 1953, the parties jointly advised the Secretary of the Third Division of their desire to withdraw this case from further consideration by the Division, which request is hereby granted.

AWARD

Case dismissed.
