FINDINGS: The Third Division of the Adjustment Board finds:

That the dispute was certified to the Third Division of the Adjustment Board ex parte by the complainant party; and

That no hearing thereon has been held, and under dates of March 8, 1955 and March 14, 1955 the parties advised the Secretary of the Third Division of their desire to withdraw this case, which request is hereby granted.
