BROTHERHOOD OF RAILWAY AND STEAMSHIP CLERKS, FREIGHT HANDLERS, EXPRESS AND STATION EMPLOYES

THE PENNSYLVANIA RAILROAD COMPANY

STATEMENT OF CLAIM: Claim of the System Committee of the Brotherhood that:

- (a) The Carrier violated the Rules Agreement, effective May 1, 1942, as amended, particularly Rule 4-A-1(a), by failing to allow Charles Kassis, extra employe, Union Station, Terre Haute, Indiana, Southwestern Division, the punitive rate of pay for his second tour of duty within twenty-four hours on June 6, and 7, 1953.
- (b) Charles Kassis, Claimant, be compensated the difference between the pro rata rate of pay allowed and the punitive rate of pay due on account of this violation. (Docket W-881)

FINDINGS: The Third Division of the Adjustment Board finds:

That the dispute was certified to the Third Division of the Adjustment Board ex parte by the complainant party; and

That no hearing thereon has been held, and under date of May 20, 1955, the complainant party addressed a formal communication to the Secretary of the Third Division requesting withdrawal of this case, which request is hereby granted.

AWARD

Case dismissed.
