### PARTIES TO DISPUTE:

## BROTHERHOOD OF RAILWAY AND STEAMSHIP CLERKS, FREIGHT HANDLERS, EXPRESS AND STATION EMPLOYES

### THE PENNSYLVANIA RAILROAD COMANY

STATEMENT OF CLAIM: Claim of the Division Committee of the Brotherhood that:

- (a) The Carrier violated the provisions of the Rules Agreement, effective May 1, 1942, except as amended, particularly the Scope and Rules 3-A-1, 3-B-1(a) and 3-D-1, when it used a Messenger (Group 2) to perform service in the Stenographic Pool (Group 1) located in the Consolidated Operating Office, Buffalo, New York, Northern Division, February 2nd and 3rd, 1954.
- (b) Clerk Stenographer Edith F. Wagner, who was qualified and available, should be allowed eight hours pay, each day, for February 2 and 3, 1954, as a penalty. (Docket C-738)

FINDINGS: The Third Division of the Adjustment Board finds:

That the dispute was certified to the Third Division of the Adjustment Board ex parte by the complainant party; and

That no hearing thereon has been held, and under date of October 6, 1955, the complainant party addressed a formal communication to the Secretary of the Third Division requesting withdrawal of this case, which request is hereby granted.

#### AWARD

Case dismissed.
