STATEMENT OF CLAIM: Claim of the System Committee of the Brotherhood that:

- (a) The Carrier violated the Clerks' Rules Agreement, effective May 1, 1942, particularly Rule 4-C-1, because it used a laborer to fill position of washman, tour of duty 4 P. M., to 12:30 A. M., at the Laundry, Dining Car Department, Sunnyside Yard, Long Island City, Long Island, New York.
- (b) D. F. Landucci be compensated for eight hours each date, at punitive rate, for August 26 and August 27, 1953, and any subsequent dates until adjusted.

FINDINGS: The Third Division of the Adjustment Board finds:

That the dispute was certified to the Third Division of the Adjustment Board ex parte by the complainant party; and

That no hearing thereon has been held, and under date of October 13, 1955, the complainant party addressed a formal communication to the Secretary of the Third Division requesting withdrawal of this case, which request is hereby granted.

AWARD

Case dismissed.
