BROTHERHOOD OF RAILWAY AND STEAMSHIP CLERKS, FREIGHT HANDLERS, EXPRESS AND STATION EMPLOYES

THE TEXAS AND PACIFIC RAILWAY COMPANY

STATEMENT OF CLAIM: Claim of the System Committee of the Brotherhood that—

- 1. Carrier violated the Clerks' Agreement October 13 and 14, 1953 when it unilaterally and arbitrarily required Clerk E. Dosher, Assistant Accountant, Job J-512, Office Auditor Expenditures, Dallas, Texas, to suspend work on his regular assigned position and perform the duties attached to position J-523 at the regular rate of pay assigned to position J-512.
- 2. That Clerk E. Dosher be additionally compensated at the rate of \$17.75 per day for October 13 and 14, 1953, which rate is assigned to position J-523.

FINDINGS: The Third Division of the Adjustment Board finds:

That the dispute was certified to the Third Division of the Adjustment Board ex parte by the complainant party; and

That no hearing thereon has been held, and under date of January 5, 1956, the complainant party addressed a formal communication to the Secretary of the Third Division requesting withdrawal of this case, which request is hereby granted.

AWARD

Case dismissed.
