PARTIES TO DISPUTE:

THE ORDER OF RAILROAD TELEGRAPHERS

THE NEW YORK CENTRAL RAILROAD COMPANY (Line West)

STATEMENT OF CLAIM: Claim of the General Committee of The Order of Railroad Telegraphers on the New York Central Railroad (Line West), that:

- 1. The Carrier violated the terms of the agreement between the parties when at 4:35 P. M. on August 3, 1954, Conductor Wm. Schneider of Work Extra 1466, performed the work of an employe covered by the agreement after the Agent-Operator at Vermilion, Ohio had been excused at the end of his tour of duty that day and before the occupant of the second shift came on duty.
- 2. The Carrier shall compensate M. Marfut the equivalent of a call under Article 5 of the Agreement because of the violation stated in paragraph 1.

FINDINGS: The Third Division of the Adjustment Board finds:

That the dispute was certified to the Third Division of the Adjustment Board ex parte by the complainant party; and

That hearing thereon has been held and concluded. Under date of February 21, 1956, the parties jointly addressed a formal communication to the Secretary of the Third Division requesting withdrawal of this case from further consideration by the Division, which request is hereby granted.

AWARD

Claim dismissed.
