THE ORDER OF RAILROAD TELEGRAPHERS

THE NEW YORK CENTRAL RAILROAD COMPANY (Line West)

STATEMENT OF CLAIM: Claim of the General Committee of The Order of Railroad Telegraphers on the New York Central Railroad (Line West of Buffalo) that:

- 1. W. J. Bildhauser shall be paid an automobile mileage allowance of 40 miles at 8¢ per mile each day he traveled between Otis and Porter March 1954 through May 27, 1954, less the payments previously made; and
- 2. N. S. Wait shall be paid an automobile mileage allowance of 40 miles at 8¢ per mile each day he traveled between Otis and Porter during April 1954 less the payments previously made.

FINDINGS: The Third Division of the Adjustment Board finds:

That the dispute was certified to the Third Division of the Adjustment Board ex parte by the complainant party; and

That hearing was waived and under date of February 21, 1956, the parties jointly addressed a formal communication to the Secretary of the Third Division requesting withdrawal of this case, which request is hereby granted.

AWARD

Claim dismissed.
