## GRAND TRUNK WESTERN RAILROAD COMPANY

STATEMENT OF CLAIM: Claim of the General Committee of The Order of Railroad Telegraphers on the Grand Trunk Western Railway Company that:

- 1. The Carrier shall pay L. H. Wheeler, 1st operator-clerk, Muskegon, eight hours at the straight time rate for Saturday, December 25, 1954, and Saturday, January 1, 1955.
- 2. The Carrier shall pay John Yenchar, Jr., 3rd operator-clerk, Ionia, eight hours at the straight time rate for Saturday, December 25, 1954, and Saturday, January 1, 1955.
- 3. The Carrier shall pay H. W. Buck, 1st operator-clerk, St. Johns, eight hours at the straight time rate for Saturday, December 25, 1954, and Saturday, January 1, 1955.
- 4. The Carrier shall pay agent-operator P. P. Bush, Greenville, eight hours at the straight time rate for Saturday, December 25, 1954, and Saturday, January 1, 1955.
- 5. The Carrier shall pay C. Grosvenor, 1st operator-clerk, Owasso, eight hours at the straight time rate for Saturday, December 25, 1954, and Saturday, January 1, 1955.

FINDINGS: The Third Division of the Adjustment Board finds:

That the dispute was certified to the Third Division of the Adjustment Board ex parte by the complainant party; and

That hearing thereon has been held but not concluded, and under date of April 26, 1956, the complainant party addressed a formal communication to the Secretary of the Third Division requesting withdrawal of this case, which request is hereby granted.

#### AWARD

Claim dismissed.
