## UNION PACIFIC RAILROAD COMPANY

STATEMENT OF CLAIM: Claim of the System Committee of the Brotherhood of Railway and Steamship Clerks, Freight Handlers, Express and Station Employes that

- (1) Carrier violates Agreement effective February 1, 1952 when they assigned and continue to permit Telegrapher-Clerk to perform rest day work of employe classified as Ticket Clerk, H. B. Piland, Manhattan, Kansas.
- (2) Carrier shall now pay Ticket Clerk H. B. Piland two additional days' pay at time and one-half rate of Ticket Clerk position from October 29, 1954 (date filed with Union Pacific Agent, Manhattan, Kansas) until such time as this violation is corrected.

FINDINGS: The Third Division of the Adjustment Board finds:

That the dispute was certified to the Third Division of the Adjustment Board ex parte by the complainant party; and

That no hearing thereon has been held, and under date of July 16, 1956, the complainant party addressed a formal communication to the Secretary of the Third Division requesting withdrawal of this case, which request is hereby granted.

#### AWARD

Case dismissed.
