BROTHERHOOD OF RAILWAY AND STEAMSHIP CLERKS, FREIGHT HANDLERS, EXPRESS AND STATION EMPLOYES

THE DENVER AND RIO GRANDE WESTERN RAILROAD COMPANY

STATEMENT OF CLAIM: Claim of the System Committee of the Brotherhood that:

- (1) The rules of the current Agreement were violated on July 31, 1955, when Engine Dispatcher-Caller Dareo Mattivi was not paid eight (8) hours at the punitive rate for working from 9:20 A. M. to 4:00 P. M., on his rest day.
- (2) That Engine Dispatcher-Caller Mattivi be paid one hour and twenty minutes additional at the punitive rate for July 31, 1955.

FINDINGS: The Third Division of the Adjustment Board finds:

That the dispute was certified to the Third Division of the Adjustment Board ex parte by the complainant party; and

That no hearing thereon has been held, and under date of October 24, 1956, the complainant party addressed a formal communication to the Secretary of the Third Division requesting withdrawal of this case, which request is hereby granted.

AWARD

Case dismissed.
